Terms & conditions of courses at Daradia: The Pain Clinic

- 1. Confirmation of registration can be done by sending confirmed flight tickets.
- 2. Payment of full course fee should be done 2 weeks before arrival either by bank transfer (mail us at info@daradia.com for details of bank if you choose this method), or, by demand draft to be drawn in favour of "Daradia-The Pain Clinic", payable at Kolkata. Send demand draft by speed post, two weeks before course.
- 3. Payment can also be done by cash on arrival. No other payment methods will be accepted for on arrival payments of course fee.
- 4. Pay full course fee by either of these three methods: demand draft, bank transfer or cash on arrival. Payments by demand draft or bank transfer are to be completed 2 weeks before arrival
- 5. No part of course fee will be refunded if someone left course after joining. 75% of course fee will be refunded if requested before joining course.
- 6. No completion certificate will be issued if course is not completed or, post course evaluation/exam is not completed.
- 7. Report at 9AM on first day and follow registration formalities. Course material will be provided on registration.
- 8. Library facility with pain management books will be provided, however books can't be taken outside clinic/hospital.
- 9. This course is affiliated with Aesculap Academy. CME credit points from Medical Council will be available only for two weeks courses & some other workshops. The courses are not affiliated with any University.
- 10. Accommodation & all food are responsibility of participants, and not included in course fee. However working veg lunch will be provided during two weeks courses and workshops.
- 11. Timing of 2 weeks' course is from 9.00AM to 4.00 PM except last day of course which will be completed at 12.30PM.
- 12. Timing of 3 months' course is from 8.30AM to 2.00 PM, or till patients are there at OPD. They will be also participating all 2 weeks courses.
- 13. Log book is to be completed for 3 months' course & 1 year fellowship.
- 14. Complimentary hostel facility is provided till seats are available.

Details/Rules for hostel are as below:

- i. Hostel is situated at 2 apartments at 1st & 2nd floor in a building, 12 KM away from clinic.
- ii. Hostels are complimentary and on first come first serve basis. Electricity charges should be borne by course participants.
- iii. Room will be provided on the day of commencement of the course till morning of last day of course. Hostel keys to be returned before certificates are awarded.
- iv. One should report at clinic for hostel on 1st day of course at 9 AM.
- v. Rooms are both AC & non-AC & rooms to be shared with other course participants.
- vi. Only minimum basic facilities are provided at hostel.
- vii. Hostel is complimentary. No reduction of course fee, if someone do not to avail hostel.
- viii. Each hostel resident should take care about cleanliness of hostel and should take care of his/her own scraps/wastes.
- ix. All valuables should be kept at own custody.
- x. Cooking is not allowed in hostel, however one can warm food at hostel microwave.
- xi. Any damage of hostel property during stay must be repaired/replaced by participants by their own.
- xii. Alcoholic drinks are strictly prohibited in hostel and participants will not be allowed to stay in hostel in violating this rule.
