

Terms & conditions of courses at Daradia: The Pain Clinic

1. Report at 9AM on first day and follow registration formalities.
2. Course material will be provided
3. Library facility with pain management books will be provided, however books can't be taken at home. It must be read at clinic only.
4. Free Wi-Fi facility will be provided at Clinic
5. Registration fees (Rs 4000.00 for Indians) are non-refundable.
6. Remaining part of course fee is fully refundable if cancelled till 21st day prior to course. 50% of course fee is refundable if cancelled between 21st to 7th days prior to course. Course fee is non-refundable if cancelled within 7 days prior to the particular course.
7. No part of course fee will be refunded if someone leaves course. No leaves are allowed during 2 weeks course. However, during other times total leaves are allowed to 3 months' course participants with prior intimation.
8. No completion certificates will be issued if course is not completed and/or post course evaluation is not completed.
9. This course is affiliated with Aesculap Academy. CME credit points will be available for two weeks courses & some other workshops. The course is not affiliated with any University.
10. Accommodation & all food are responsibility of participants, must be arranged by themselves and not included in course fee. However, working packet vegetarian lunch will be provided only during 2 weeks' courses.
11. Timing of 2 weeks' course is from 9AM to 4.30 PM except last day of course which will be completed at 12.30PM. 3 months' course participants will be participating all 2 weeks courses. Other days except these 2 weeks' courses timing for 3 months' course is from 9AM to 2PM, Mon to Sat except national holidays.
12. Complimentary hostel facility is provided till seats are available.

Rules for hostel are as below:

- i. Hostel is situated at 2 apartments at 1st & 2nd floor in a building, 12 KM away from clinic.
- ii. Hostels are complimentary and on first come first serve basis. Electricity charges should be borne by course participants based on actual uses on meter reading.
- iii. Hostel rooms will be provided from one day before (afternoon) commencement of the course and upto morning of next to last day of course.
- iv. One should report between 11AM to 7PM at hostel on previous day of commencement of course or report at clinic on 1st day of course at 9 AM.
- v. Hostels are non-AC & shared with other course participants.
- vi. Only minimum basic facilities are provided at hostel and no request for improving/adding the facilities will be entertained.
- vii. No reduction of course fee, if someone do not to avail hostel.
- viii. Each hostel resident should take care about cleanliness of hostel and should take care of his/her own scraps/wastes.
- ix. All valuables and cashes should be kept at own risks.
- x. Cooking is not allowed in hostel, however one can take food that is brought from outside and warm it at hostel.
- xi. Any damage of hostel property must be repaired/replaced by participants by their own.
- xii. Alcoholic drinks are strictly prohibited in hostel and participants will not be allowed to stay in hostel in violating this rule.
